Humshaugh & District Pre-school is a parent run Pre-school based in Humshaugh C of E Aided First School. We are members of the Pre-school Learning Alliance and also a registered charity.

Established in 1982, we have continued to provide quality low-cost childcare. We believe in learning through play, offering a wide range of fun activities for our children, encouraging them to express themselves creatively, to learn about the world they live in and develop their personal and social skills.

We are registered with Ofsted to take up to 24 children between the ages of two and five, and inspected on a regular basis – copies of our inspections reports are available for your reference, please ask. We do not insist that children are potty trained. Children with special needs are also welcome.

Session Times

We currently operate three sessions per week, 9.15 am to 11.45 am on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

We run an extra session in the Summer term on a Thursday afternoon, for those children attending school the following September—'The Rising Fives'. They bring a packed lunch and are supervised by parents over the lunch time period. The afternoon session concentrates on activities which are more advanced, in a more classroom-like environment. The group only runs if numbers permit.

Parent Involvement

As we are a parent run body, our committee is made up of Parents/carers who in partnership with the staff, organise and run the Pre-school.

We actively encourage Parents/carers to become involved in Pre-school—your views are always welcome.

We, as with most Pre-schools, need to fundraise throughout the year to meet our costs, keep our fees low and provide new toys and equipment for the children.
