#### New starters

## Swimming

The children will be swimming this half term and the first session is on <u>Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> September</u>. Please return the permission slip with £24 (8 sessions @ £3) to the office as soon as possible. As usual children will need to bring a **swimming costume/trunks, goggles and a towel in a suitable bag**. We will travel by bus at 10.30 am to the Wentworth Leisure Centre. The lesson is 11-11.30 am and we return to school for lunch. We already have a number of experienced volunteers so there is no need for you to come and help your child to change, however you are welcome to sit in the foyer and watch the lesson.

We welcome Mr Dimmick our new PE teacher who will teach PE across the school and also run an after school sports club on Mondays.

## Forest School

**From next week** - **<u>FRIDAY 14</u><sup>TH</sup> <u>SEPTEMBER</u>**, Forest School will start again which will be led by Miss Osborne and Mrs Phillips. **On Fridays,** children will need to wear practical outdoor trousers/leggings and sturdy waterproof shoes or boots to school rather than ordinary school uniform.

If possible, we would like parents to provide their child with a clearly labelled pair of wellies, waterproof coat and trousers that can be kept at school. If anybody has difficulty providing these please let us know.

## Attendance

Many children had very good attendance and hit the target of 98% or above last year. However, a worrying number of children had well below this expected target.

It states in the Hexham Partnership of School Policy for Leave of Absence during term time leaflet, "If your child's attendance falls below 93% it is of great concern to us and we have to discuss the issue with our Education Welfare Office."

Please ensure your child is in school every day unless unwell. Parents must contact the school office or leave a message on the answer machine giving a reason for absence.

To celebrate excellent attendance, we will be announcing the year group with the best attendance each week during our Friday Star of the week Collective Worship. The children in that year group will be given a sticker and presented with the Attendance cup to look after for week. If there is a tie, each year group will share the cup for an equal amount of time. The Year group Attendance percentages will be displayed in the front window and on the website.

#### **Routines**

Please remember to arrive promptly to school in the morning. <u>The bell is rung for school to start at 8.50am</u>. Please do not leave children unattended until you are sure that Mrs Phillips is on duty in the yard.

<u>Late book-</u>we are going continue monitoring punctuality using our Late Book from the beginning of term. If children arrive after the back doors are locked, they are required to be dropped off at the front door. A member of staff will fill in the late book and escort your child to their classroom.

Please also ensure you arrive on time at <u>3.05pm</u> to pick your child up at the end of the day.
