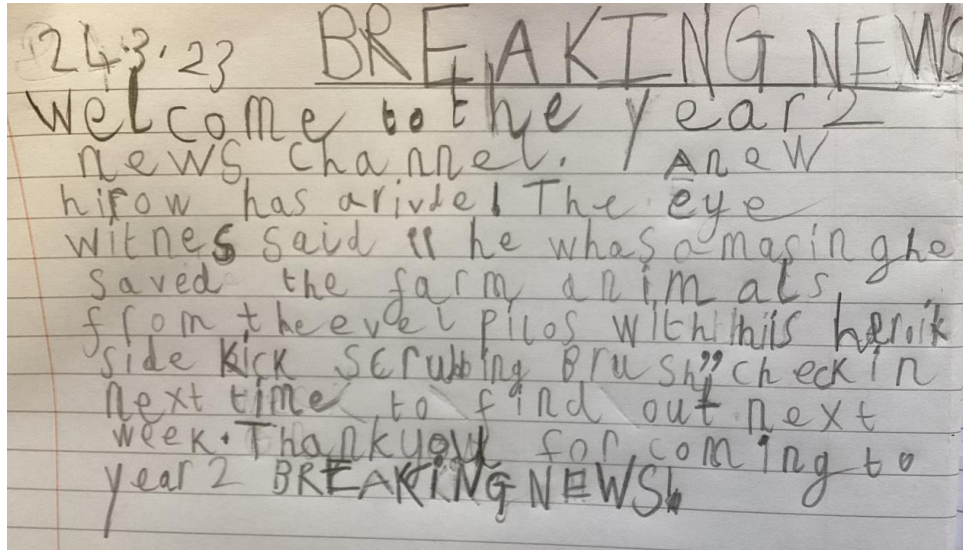
LIVING EGGS
