HLT Consultation

The Hadrian Learning Trust (HMS and QEH) have published their consultation document to become a Secondary School (lowering the age range of QEH to Year 7). This will have a significant impact on all the First and Middle Schools in the area. I emailed all parents last week with the full consultation. If you do not receive communication by email, there will be a hard copy of the summary in your child's book bag with details of where to find the full consultation and how to respond. As with the West Northumberland Schools Consultation, I urge you to read the full document and respond by the deadline.
