This can be recorded in their reading record and team points will be awarded for regular reading.</p>	<p>Help at home x tables: Please encourage your children to practise multiplication tables 1-12. These underpin many mathematical concepts. Learning the sequences by heart will assist the children in being able to answer x table questions randomly. Y3: 2,5,10, 3, 4, 6 and 7 Y4: As above and 8,9,11,12</p>
