#### **PARENT PAY**

We are in the process of going 'cashless' with a new system called Parent Pay. Parents of children from Nursery to Year 4 will receive a letter with all the relevant information to activate the account. We will be using the system from the first day of term so any school meals that are to be paid for will be recorded. PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH OR CHEQUES in. Even though **children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 still receive Universal Free School meals, parents should activate their accounts because as soon as possible, we will organise swimming, school trip payments and consent forms using ParentPay. If you have more than one child at the school, there is an option to merge the account.** Information can be found on the activation letter. #### **PE and Sports club**

We welcome Mrs Alderslade our new PE teacher who will teach PE across the school and also run an after school sports club on Mondays.

Due to limited space, please ensure bags are the drawstring type rather than large rucksacks.

#### **Forest School**

**If possible, we would like parents to provide their child with a clearly labelled pair of wellies, waterproof coat and trousers that can be kept at school.** If anybody has difficulty providing these please let us know.

#### **Harvest Festival**

We would like to invite parents, relatives and friends to our **Harvest Festival and Community Soup lunch on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October**. The children will help prepare the vegetables in the morning and the Friends volunteers will make the soup ready for approximately 1.15pm. Guests are invited to stay for the Harvest Festival which will include songs and poems to celebrate Harvest.

We would ask that all children bring in a decorated shoe box with a few goodies in it such as tins, packets of pasta or biscuits. The children will then deliver these gifts around the village on **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> October**.

### **Attendance**

Many children had very good attendance and hit the target of 97% or above last year. However, a worrying number of children had well below this expected target.

**It states in the Hexham Partnership of School Policy for Leave of Absence during term time leaflet, "If your child's attendance falls below 93% it is of great concern to us and we have to discuss the issue with our Education Welfare Office."**

Please ensure your child is in school every day unless unwell. Parents must contact the school office or leave a message on the answer machine giving a reason for absence.

**To celebrate excellent attendance, we will continue to announce the year group/s with the best attendance each week during our Friday Star of the week Collective Worship. The children in that year group will be given a sticker and presented with the Attendance cup to look after for the week. If there is a tie, each year group will share the cup for an equal amount of time.**

**The Year group Attendance percentages will be displayed in the front window and on the website.**
