CLASS 3 TRIP TO THE ROMAN ARMY MUSEUM AND VINDOLANDA

Using a learning pack from the Vindolanda Education team, the children worked in small groups to find various pieces of information and recorded this on worksheets. Our visit finished off with a lesson in a Roman classroom with a virtual teacher. We then travelled on to Vindolanda for lunch and we were joined by a friend of Mrs Long's who is part of the Education team. She gave us a guided tour of the fort and helped us with the clues for a Hidden Word activity. The highlight of the visit was the children's reinactment of Romans versus Celts on the replica wooden and stone forts. They were certainly fearsome!
