We are asking each child, if possible, to bring in to school **one item from the list** which would be a suitable gift for a child in either the **2-4**, **5-9** or **10-14** age categories, to add to their **class shoeboxes**. Members of the School Council will be filling and wrapping the shoeboxes and we would like to send them off on **Friday 15th November** in order to meet delivery deadlines. If your family would like to make up their own box to send, instead of contributing to the class box, we would welcome these too.
