#### **New starters**

#### **Outdoor Learning**

**From this week**, Friday afternoons will be dedicated to Outdoor Learning which will be led by Miss Osborne and Mrs Phillips. We are very excited about making this a rich and stimulating curriculum experience for the children. The intention is to go outside every week, for at least a part of the afternoon, whatever the weather.

On Fridays, children will need to wear practical outdoor trousers/leggings and sturdy waterproof shoes or boots to school rather than ordinary school uniform. We still would like children to wear their Humshaugh First School sweatshirt or cardigan.

If possible, we would like parents to provide their child with a clearly labelled pair of wellies, waterproof coat and trousers that can be kept at school. If anybody has difficulty providing these please let us know.

### **Harvest Festival**

We would like to invite parents, relatives and friends to our <u>Harvest Festival and Community Soup lunch on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> September</u>. The children will help prepare the vegetables in the morning and parent volunteers will make the soup ready for approximately 1.15pm. Guests are invited to stay for the Harvest Festival which will include songs and poems to celebrate Harvest.

We would ask that all children bring in a decorated shoe box with a few goodies in it such as tins, packets of pasta or biscuits. The children will then deliver these gifts around the village on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> October.

In addition to bringing in a box, the Friends would also like to run a competition for best decorated vegetable. More information about when to bring in boxes and entries will be sent out nearer the time.

#### **Attendance**

Many children had very good attendance and hit the target of 97% or above last year. However, a worrying number of children had well below this expected target.

It states in the Hexham Partnership of School Policy for Leave of Absence during term time leaflet, "If your child's attendance falls below 93% it is of great concern to us and we have to discuss the issue with our Education Welfare Office." Please ensure your child is in school every day unless unwell. Parents must contact the school office or leave a message on the answer machine giving a reason for absence.

## **Routines**

Please remember to arrive promptly to school in the morning. The bell is rung for school to start at 8.50am.

Parents should leave their children in the playground where they will be escorted into school by Mrs Phillips.

<u>Late book</u>-we are going continue monitoring punctuality using our Late Book from the beginning of term. If children arrive after the back doors are locked, they are required to be dropped off at the front door. A member of staff will fill in the late book and escort your child to their classroom.

Please also ensure you arrive on time at 3.05pm to pick your child up at the end of the day.

We will be doing PE outside in the autumn term, so please make sure your child has a suitable PE kit and sandshoes with velcro fastening or trainers that he/she can fasten independently.
