ATTENDANCE

Humshaugh First School has an attendance target of 98% for each pupil.

We understand there may be unavoidable and/or genuine reasons for a pupil's absence.

Irregular school attendance may have a serious impact on your child's academic progress. For this reason, we ask that you:

- * Where possible make medical appointments outside of school hours
- *Only allow your child to stay at home in response to genuine illness
- *Avoid taking holidays during term time.

Attendance at Humshaugh First School is regularly monitored. If pupils have persistently low attendance, a letter is sent home. If low attendance continues, the Educational Welfare Officer becomes involved. Our full Attendance Policy is on our website.
