

Humshaugh Cof E (Aided) First School Sport Premium Proposed Spend Plan 2022-2023

In 2022-2023 the school will receive £16,360. The funding will be used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning of PE across the whole school. We have changed our PE and Club Provider to NUFC and are trialling this service working with Coach Paul Ballantyne who will assist in the planning and delivery of PE across Key Stage 1 and 2 and lead a weekly after school sports club for children from Year 1to Year 4. We will continue to encourage children to lead healthy and active lifestyles through our teaching and learning and organised events such as Skipping, Dance Marathons, Hoopstarz and wide range of free After School Clubs which include Dance, Football, Yoga and Zumba.

We will actively encourage our children to take part in competitive sport. Having already seen the impact of funding from previous years we hope for this year's funding to continue to have a lasting impact on provision of PE and sport within our school. Areas to address in PE this year are to audit equipment and purchase a range of new items, focus on Lower Key Stage 2 swimming attainment, focus on progression in PE with a new provider and to focus on participation and enjoyment of sport, following the government plan for children to have at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day.
