PE this term

We will be doing PE outside in the Summer term, so please make sure your child has sandshoes with velcro fastening or trainers that he/she can fasten independently. Please ensure that your child comes to school in full school uniform. Thank you.

Water bottles and sun cream

Please remember to send your child to school with a water bottle each day. It is really important that your child stays hydrated in the warner weather. Sun cream should be applied to your child before he/she comes to school and this will provided protection for the day.

Reading Challenge

To encourage children to read more regularly out of school, we will be hosting a mini reading challenge over the May half term holiday. Any child who reads 10 times over the holiday will get a certificate and a small reward. The recommended time for a child to read or listen to stories each day is 15 minutes for children in EYFS, 20 minutes for KS1 children and 25-30 minutes for children in lower KS2. This can be school reading books, magazines, comics, newspapers or any other form of reading.
