BANANAGRAMS

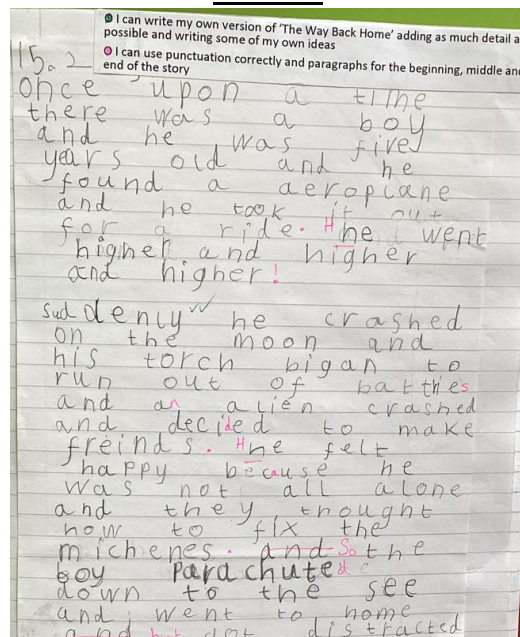
