SALMON IN THE CLASSROOM-TYNE RIVER TRUST

We are really delighted to be offered the chance to take part in 'Salmon in the Classroom' this year-thank you to Charlotte's dad Jamie for thinking of us. The Tyne River Trust will source the salmon eggs from Kielder hatchery and the project involves a fish tank being set up in school. When the salmon eggs are delivered, all classes will have a short session talking about the North Atlantic salmon, its lifecycle and role in food chains etc.

Once the salmon eggs are placed into the tank the children will learn how to look after them by keeping an eye on the temperature. The final part of the project is the release day which is likely to take place just before the Easter holidays when the salmon are at the 'Fry' stage of their life cycle and are swimming up looking for food.

The fish will be syphoned from the tank and the children in Years 3 and 4 will help release them in the nearby burn and do some kick sampling in the river to look for invertebrates.



WORLD BOOK DAY-THURSDAY 2ND MARCH

To celebrate World Book Day, we are inviting children to come to school in 'home clothes' and to bring their favourite book to share. If it is possible for the home clothes to link with a book or character then that would be great, but please do not feel obliged to provide a book day costume.
