

Humshaugh KS2 RE - Autumn (1) 2014 - 2015

Topic Outline

We will be developing our RE skills by thinking about the use of symbolism and improving our knowledge of the Bible including using Bible references. We will further our knowledge of other religions by studying the Jewish Harvest Festival of Sukkot, looking at how Jewish people celebrate and listening to a story from the Old Testament to help understand why they do things in a certain way.

Humshaugh KS2 French - Autumn (1) 2014 - 2015

Topic Outline

We will start our study of French by learning some greetings, how to say our names, the numbers to 12 and the colours. We will use our knowledge of the colours to help us understand a short story about animals, before making up our own version of the story.

Humshaugh KS2 RE - Autumn (2) 2014 - 2015

Topic Outline

We will be discussing the rules and codes for living set out in the Five Pillars of Islam and identifying the impact some of the main practices of Islam have on the lives of Muslim people. We will look to see if there are

any links between our own way of life and that of the Muslim people.

Our focus for Christmas will be **God with us**. The children will have the opportunity to reflect upon Christmas as a celebration of God's presence with us 2000 years ago and now, making links between Christian beliefs and the nativity story.

French KS2 Autumn (2) 2014 - 2015

Topic Outline

We will be reading and listening to the story of Boucle d'Or (Goldilocks and The Three Bears). We will learn strategies to help us follow a longer text in French and we will identify the key nouns in the story. We will be learning about French nouns being masculine or feminine and about the use of adjectives.
