VINDOLANDA ARTEFACTS SESSION

Following on from their class trip to the Roman Army Museum and Vindolanda, the children had a fantastic session with Anneke who we met at Vindolanda. She brought a wide range of artefacts for the children to observe, touch and analyse. They started by thinking what the objects were. They were then given a set of clue cards which they had to decide were relevant to the artefacts on their table. All groups visited each table to investigate the different artefacts, raising questions and lines of enquiry. The groups then joined together to create a museum exhibition with chosen artefacts. A few children reported to the class their findings. Finally, the children completed an artefact investigation sheet.
