### **AWARDS AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

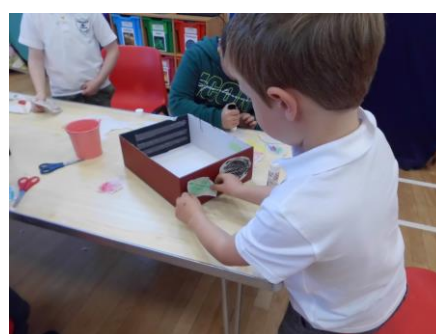
