Even though children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 still receive Universal Free School meals, parents should activate their accounts because as soon as possible, we will organise swimming, breakfast club, milk and school trip payments and consent forms using ParentPay. If you have more than one child at the school, there is an option to merge the account. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, you still need to activate your account for the reasons stated above.

The children in that year group will be given a sticker and presented with the Attendance Cup to look after for the week. If there is a tie, each year group will share the cup for an equal amount of time.
