If your child is a more confident reader please encourage them to read silently but give opportunities for discussing the text.</p>	<p>Help at home x tables: Please encourage your children to practise multiplication tables 1-12. These underpin many mathematical concepts. Learning the sequences by heart will assist the children in being able to answer x table questions randomly. Y2: 2, 5, 10 Y3: 3 and 4 Y4: 6,7,8,9,11,12</p>
