

End of Nursery Curricular Goals



Communication & Language

Listen to others in 1-1 and small groups even if the topic is not chosen by self.
Understand instructions containing words related to time and basic 'wh' questions.
Express ideas including saying what they are going to do and recounting past events in the correct order.
Use clear speech which can be understood by others most of the time.
Play imaginatively with other children, taking on different roles.



Personal, Social & Emotional

Use words instead of actions most of the time to negotiate with other children and adapt to new situations in school.

Show **kindness** and **care** for younger children and friends and understand how to **take turns** and **share**. Can use the **toilet independently** including washing hands and will **ask adults for help** when needed.



Physical

Run smoothly negotiating space and travel confidently over, under, around and through equipment.

Hold a pencil using the modified tripod grip and draw a person with head body, legs and arms. Cut a straight line with scissors.



Literacy

Recognise some letters of own name in other words, orally blend C-V-C to make a word, add to a rhyming string and hear and say initial sounds in words.

Listen to stories to the end, answer questions about them and able to retell familiar ones. Copy own name and use 'writing' in independent play.



Mathematical

Count objects to 5 with one-to- one correspondence and respond to 'how many altogether?' Make small same size sets of dissimilar items (up to 5 in a set) e.g. find 4 bears to go with 4 chairs. Count different things e.g. steps, hops, claps. Share up to 4 objects between 2 people fairly.



Understanding the World

Talk about own family, past events and memories.

Notice and show respect for differences between people and families.

Talk about **different occupations** using appropriate vocabulary and demonstrate them in role play. Know that there are **different countries** and **different environments** in the world. Explore, talk about and show care for the **natural world** including observing how **plants grow**. Investigate and talk about **different properties of materials** and **forces**, observe and talk about their **changes**.



Expressive Arts & Design

Engage in pretend play with others using objects to represent other objects and complex small world play. Listen attentively to sounds or music and respond to what they hear expressing their thoughts and feelings. Sing entire songs, copying the melodic shape, play instruments and start to create their own songs or music. Choose from different materials and textures to create own ideas, joining them together independently. Draw shapes to represent objects and faces with features, showing different emotions in their drawings.

Humshaugh Early Years Unit will provide opportunities for children to achieve these goals by the end of their time in Nursery, giving them access to a high-quality curriculum and working in partnership with parents to support their learning at home.
