YOUTH CLUB

Humshaugh Youth Club – Lisa Robinson (North Tyne Youth) and Herbie Newell

North Tyne Youth (<u>https://www.facebook.com/northtyneyouth/</u>) are exploring the possibility of providing structured out-of-school activities for young people in Humshaugh. Two youth clubs are being considered, one for juniors (8-11 years old) and one for seniors (12-18 years old). The clubs would be in the evening once a week during school term time, and in school holidays there would be the possibility of taking in part in organised activities. Suitably qualified North Tyne Youth staff would run the clubs, to ensure that all regulatory requirements are met, supported by adult volunteers from the Village.

North Tyne Youth currently plan to run "taster" sessions towards the end of the forthcoming Summer Term, offer access to their programme of summer holiday activities and, if there is sufficient demand, start running weekly clubs in Humshaugh from September 2022.

As a family with school-aged children we would like to know if you think your children would be interested in attending a youth club, either currently or when they reach the appropriate age, if one was to be set up.
