Tuffy had a lovely time with Arte at the weekend.



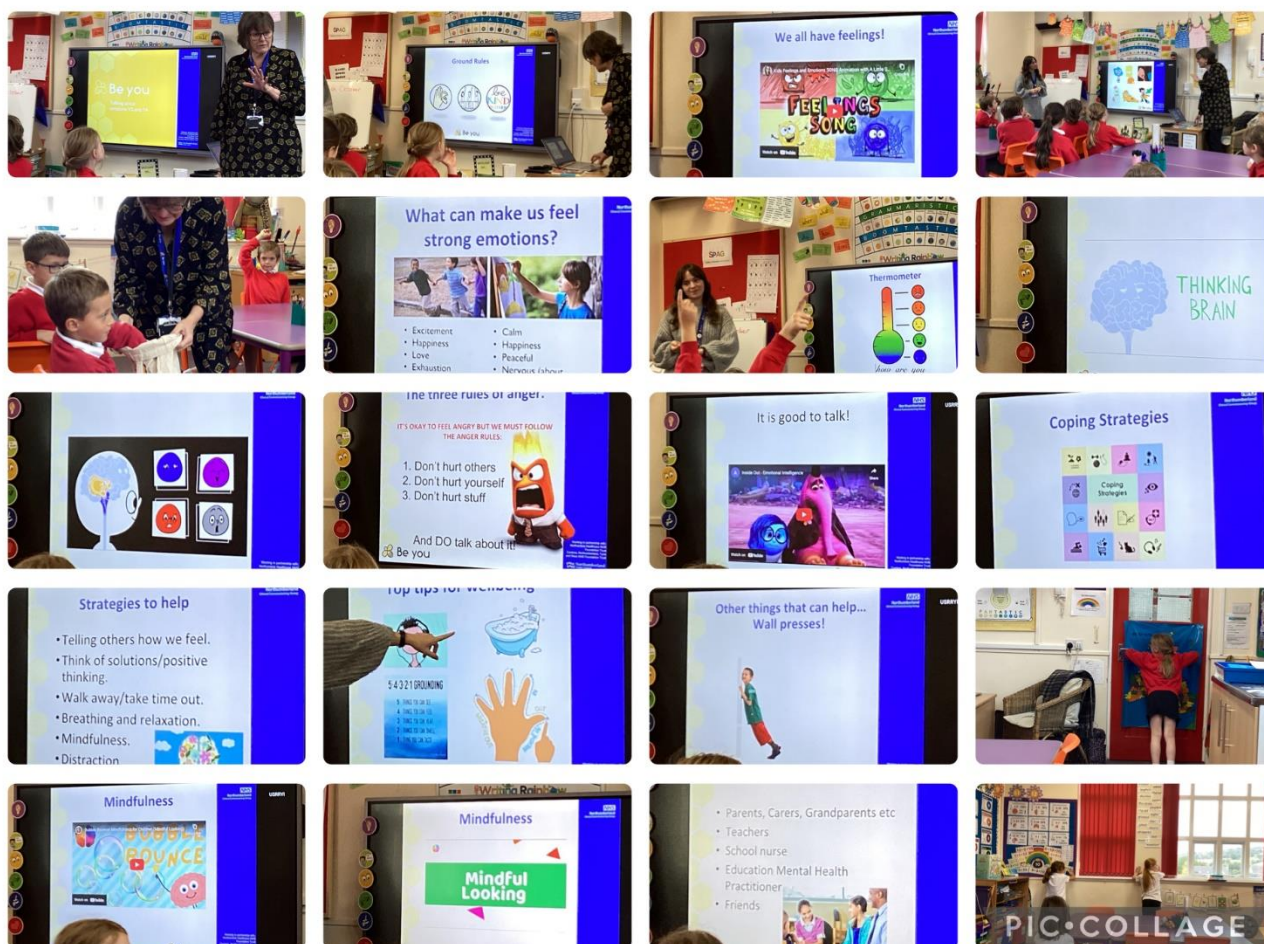
