

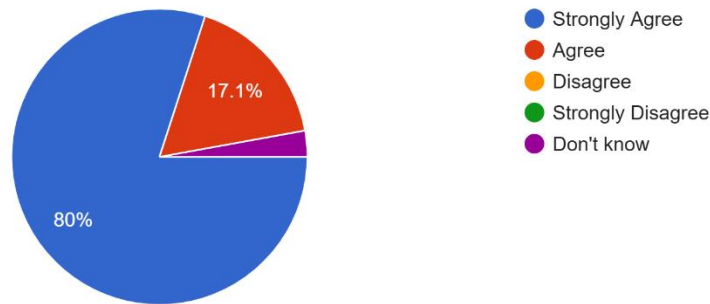
Parent Questionnaire Results – May 26

My children are happy to go to school every day, getting ready (mostly) by themselves and never dragging their feet in. They are both excited for days of learning and are nurtured to

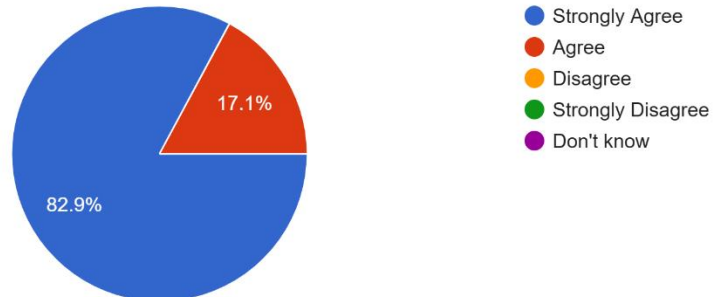
grow to their full potential. My child is happy at this school and as parents, we are so happy to see them thrive at Humshaugh First School.

She has never complained of feeling unsafe

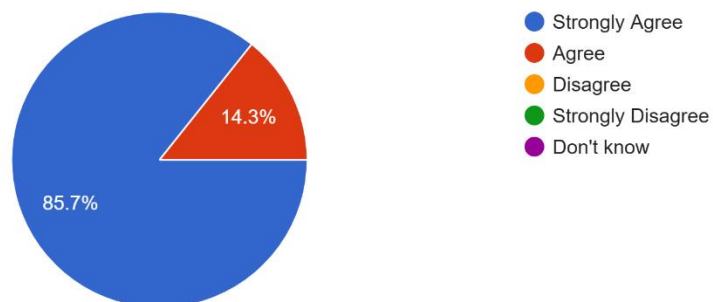

she has been provided with tools to help her in lessons

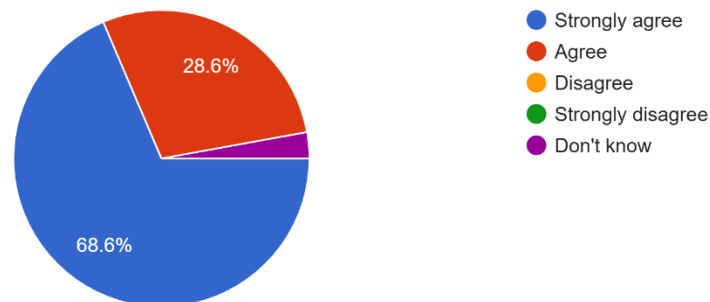
I couldn't have asked for nicer staff. They are all brilliant

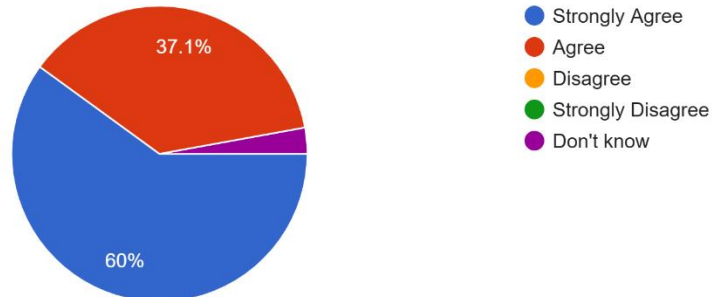

I'm very impressed at how Jude Long ensures everyone is well behaved. This is very evident at group events such as sports day.

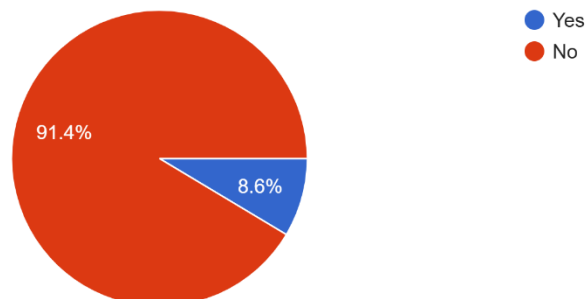
Yes, I love the idea of the different colour teddies.

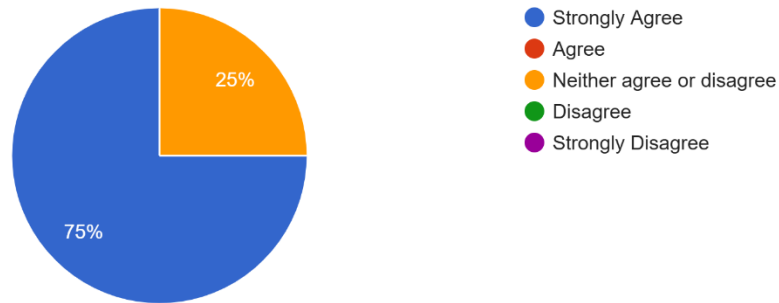

If you answered Yes. When the bullying took place the school deal with bullying quickly and effectively?

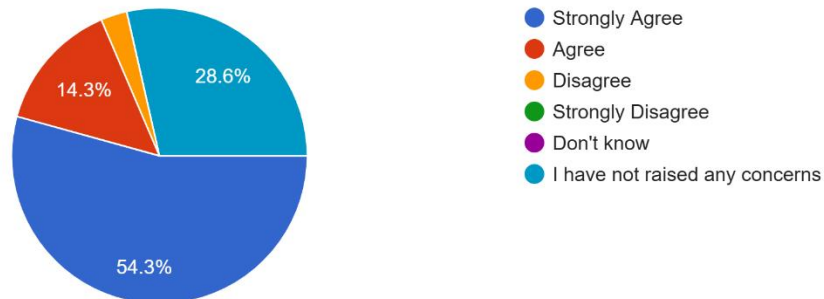

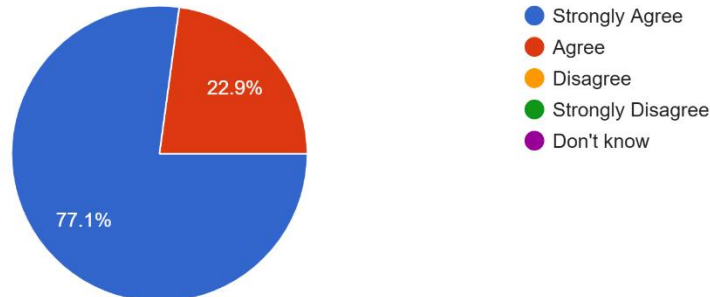

It would be nice if all information is in one place. Sometimes information is missed when there are numerous emails. The quality of information is excellent.

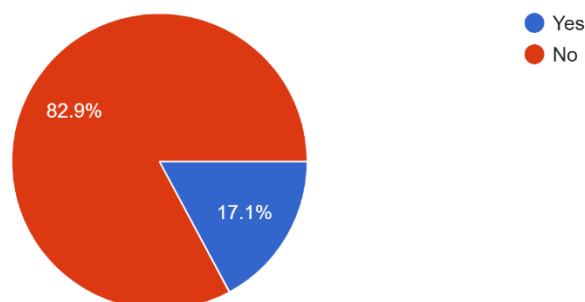
Abby is fantastic in the office and goes above and beyond, she's really friendly.

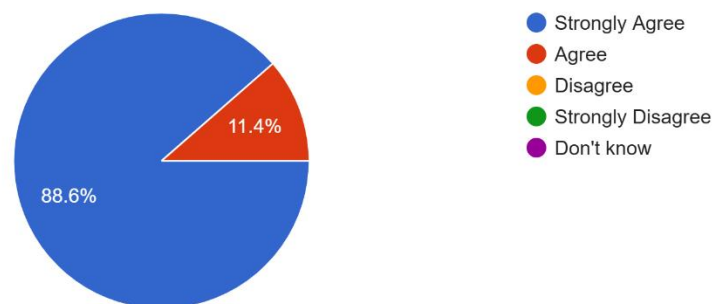
