Lateness

There have been a growing number of late entries in the Late book in the last couple of weeks and it is often the same children who are arriving after the bell has been rung. **The bell rings at 8.50am so that children are in class by 8.55am.** If you arrive after the bell has been rung, please buzz on the front door.

Children will be taken to the cloak room by a member of staff.

Parents DO NOT need to accompany children through the school.

Regular lateness has an impact on your child's learning as instructions are given as soon as they enter the classroom and children start learning tasks straight away. If children come in late they are already having to catch up with their peers. Many children have interventions and extra support with our Teaching Assistants first thing in the morning. It is a waste of their time if they are having to wait for children to arrive in school. We know as adults that it is vital that we are good timekeepers for jobs and appointments therefore it is beneficial for children be encouraged to be on time for school. Please help us by ensuring your child is in school promptly.
