We would like to send books home shortly before the summer holidays. Please send in a named bag for life with your child so it is ready for the big book take home!!

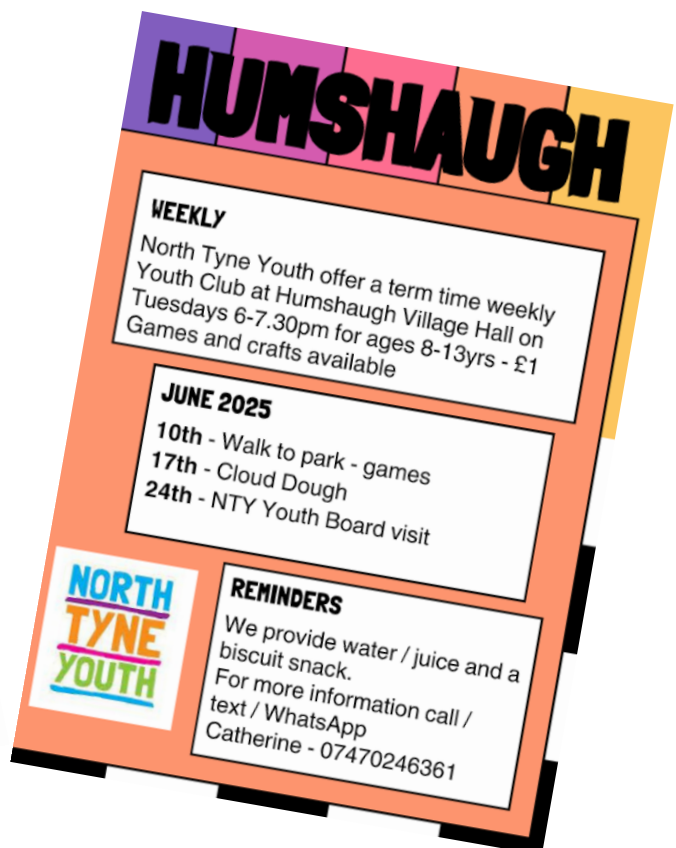
