



Humshaugh Cof E First School Sport Premium Report 2019-2020

In 2019-2020 the school received £16,360. The funding was used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning of PE across the whole school. We found a provider that offered better value for money-Active Northumberland and introduced our children to new experiences and opportunities within sport. They provided support and advice for existing staff and those new to school and new to year groups. We continued to encourage children to lead healthy and active lifestyles through our teaching and learning and organised events such as health and fitness week. We actively encouraged our children to take part in competitive sport including Gymnastics, Tag Rugby, Tennis, Tri-Golf and Quadkids.

The pupils are proficient at working as a team and working through any

After school club coach-Zumba class	£3960 (Weekly throughout the year)	Reception to Year 4 (x3 Pre school children)	Pupils have experienced a wide range of dance genres and styles and different cultures. They have time to learn the Zumba dances and to make art and crafts linked with the country of the session.
Broomley Grange Residential	£500	Staff costs and travel	The Year 4 children were able to experience being away from home and mix with children from other schools who will be joining them at Middle School.
Advisory PE teacher	£5000	SA/JL/KB	The teacher has supported staff in development of teaching PE and organised a number of inter and intra sporting competitions through the year, ensuring children are competition ready. She has also contributed to the school gaining their Silver School Games award.
After school sports club	£1500 (Weekly throughout the year)	SA	A very popular club enabling children to have more opportunities to develop physical skills in a variety of different sports and promote a healthy lifestyle.
Equipment-Howlers/Badminton nets	£200	SA/JL	Sports club were able to have badminton taking place across the hall.
