

## Humshaugh C of E First School Sport Premium Report 2024-2025

In 2024-2025 the school received £16,430. The funding was used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning of PE across the whole school. We have a part time qualified teacher Mr Hulbert who teaches PE across Key stage 1 and 2 in addition to leading an extracurricular sports club. Children also had opportunities to take part in Quadkids and Rounders and also a Skipping Festival at the Wentworth Leisure Centre. Our excellent after school provision has continued and we offer a wide range of free After School Clubs which include Multi-Skills, Dance, Football, Yoga and Zumba. Unfortunately, due to personal circumstances, Rachel our Yoga instructor had to finish her Yoga club in the Autumn term as did Stephen Cheal from Supastrikers. We were able to replace the provider with Full of Beans who have been delivering Football club every Wednesday.

We have also focussed on swimming attainment and the children in Years 1 to 4 have been attending weekly swimming lessons throughout the year (as opposed to alternate half terms as in previous years) and the impact is very noticeable. More children have moved into the big pool and more children are able to swim 25 metres on their front and back. Next year, we will actively encourage our children to take part in competitive sport, we will audit equipment and purchase a range of new items, continue to focus on Lower Key Stage 2 swimming attainment, focus on progression in PE and focus on participation and enjoyment of sport, following the government plan for children to have at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day.
