GREEN SKILLS

We had a super visit from Connor Thompson, Green Skills Schools Engagement Officer at Northumberland College on Tuesday. Connor is working on project funded by the North of Tyne Combined Authority; the aim is to raise the awareness of careers available in the Green Sector across key stages 1-4.

The project has worked with key employers in North of Tyne and Northumberland from the Green Sectors including.

- Green Energy
- Green Transport
- Green Construction

The aims of the project are to engage as many pupils as possible in Green Skills. The session introduced the children to the type of jobs in the Green Sector followed by a practical activity to build wind turbines, which developed into an in-class competition.

The children were given a time limit to build a wind turbine with careful consideration of the spacing and angle of the blades. They tested their turbines by using a fan and measuring the voltage using a Voltmeter. The winning team received a toy electric car. There are more photos on our website.
