As part of our ongoing PSHE curriculum, we have booked several more session across the year which will cover topics like Friendship, Anxiety and Transition. Joy and Sarah were really impressed with how the children could articulate their feelings and some of the ways to regulate and feel better if angry or sad. Our work using the Colour Monster story and the film Inside Out is having a real impact on how children view themselves and others and we will continue our focus on Mental Health and Well Being throughout the year.
