SCHOOL LIBRARY-LOVE OF READING!

We have been very fortunate to have Deborah Whinney, Library Supervisor from the Schools Library Service working with Miss Osborne and one of our governors Jenny to improve our library. She has spent several days categorising our books following the Dewy system and helping us to organise the library so it is much more accessible for children to use independently.

We are in the process of borrowing and purchasing sets of books particularly for older readers and have introduced a new system for children to sign books in and out. Each week, children will take turns to have a library session with Jenny to discuss favourite books and find out where to locate certain books and enjoy reading to themselves and others.

Our Class 3 Librarians will also be responsible for keeping the library tidy and will lead a club on a Thursday lunchtime with activities such as book hunts, comic strip making and story reading. We hope that this will continue to encourage a love of reading for all our children and are delighted with the results so far.
