FUNDRAISER FOR ZERO HUNGER

We were really pleased to receive the following email this week.

Dear Jude and all the staff, pupils and families of Humshaugh First School

Thank you all for the very generous and thoughtful donation of £60 donated by the Children of following their Bring & Buy Toy fundraiser in aid of Zero Hunger.

I wanted to let you all know that this support really does help to make a difference for local people experiencing poverty. As demand on our services continue to grow we need the support and generosity of local people who donate food and money more than ever.

Last year to September 30th has been our busiest year ever, we supported 1005 adults and almost 700 children experiencing poverty which is more than we have ever had to help in 11 years and 100 more children than the previous year.

Our team of 22 warehouse volunteers processed over 200 food parcels a week and made 5050 doorstep deliveries of around 7330 tinned and dried food parcels worth around £15 each and over 3,100 fresh food parcels along with over 3700 packs of household essentials such as toilet roll, nappies, toiletries, washing powder and pet food.

Our team of 26 volunteer drivers have covered over 25,000 miles in our 3 vans taking vital supplies to 740 households across 50 Towns and Villages. Approximately £87,500 worth stock was donated by local people, but funds from donors like yourself helped us buy in additional supplies over £53,000.
