Appeal for Household Items for four Ukrainian Families Arriving in the Tyne Valley

I am helping a friend organise the arrival of four Ukrainian families to Corbridge. With visas in place the first two families are due to arrive next week, the remaining two families the week after. Rental properties have been secured for them in Corbridge that are currently being decorated but they are unfurnished. So now it is a race against the clock trying to get them ready in time and we are looking for a number of things:

Bedframes (Kings, doubles, singles), mattresses, bedside tables Bedding (duvets, pillows) Wardrobe(s) Sofas and cushions / throws Dining / kitchen table and chairs Rugs and lamps Cabinets, coffee table Chest of drawers Kitchen items (cooking, eating)

There is a 5 month old baby with the first group so we also need baby equipment: Pushchair and accessories (possibly they have one with them we just don't know yet and so are looking for a backup) Bouncer Play mat Highchair Weaning equipment Night light Cot sheets Baby blankets Grow bags Muslins Baby towels...

The list goes on, as you know babies come with a lot of stuff!

Needless to say we are grateful for any help. The properties need to be signed off by the Council so need to be compliant with safety standards and all items in good or nearly new condition (fire retardant tags, no rips etc). If items could be clean and ready to go before being passed on that would be a massive help given the amount to do and the time available. I will be waiting outside the gate to Early Years on Tues/Wed pick up if you have anything to contribute that I could put your name against.
