

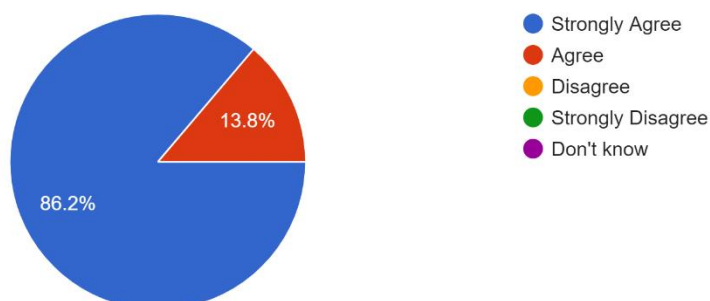
Parent Questionnaire Results – May 2024

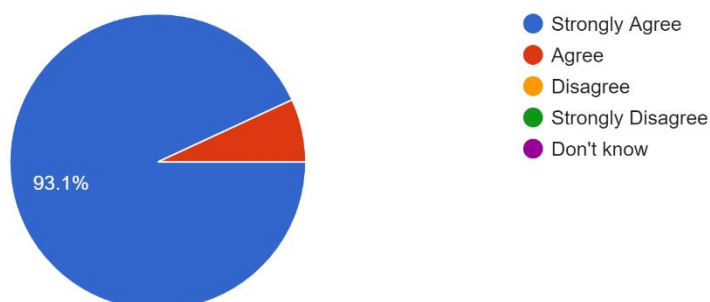
Comments

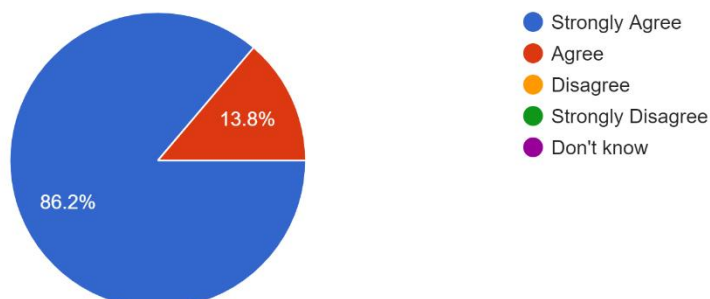
I've had no concerns at all about the safety of my child.

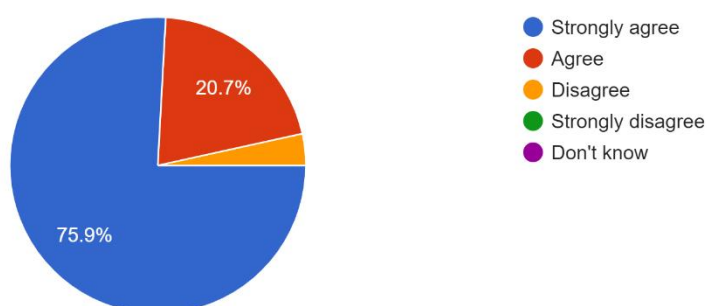

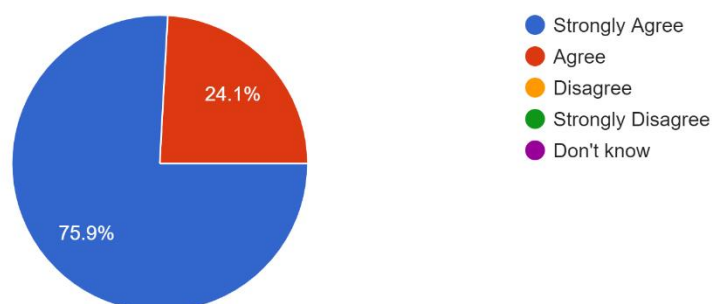
The standard of learning is very high, but with the support and encouragement they receive, it is achievable.

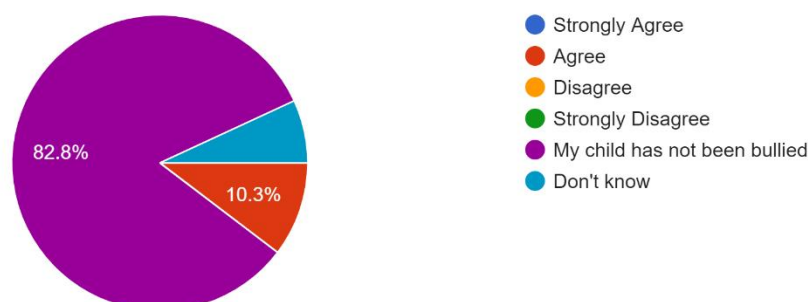

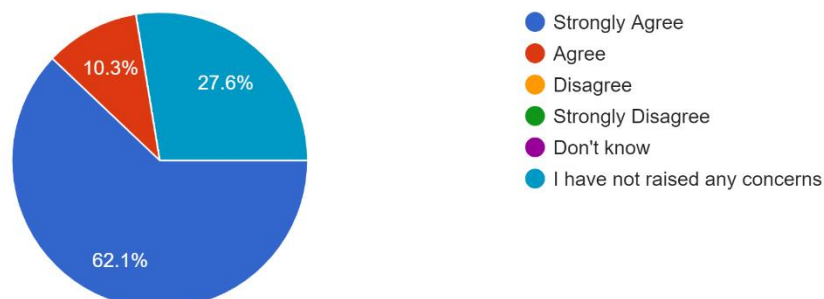
Any issues that we have had, have been dealt with quickly before it has turned into something else.

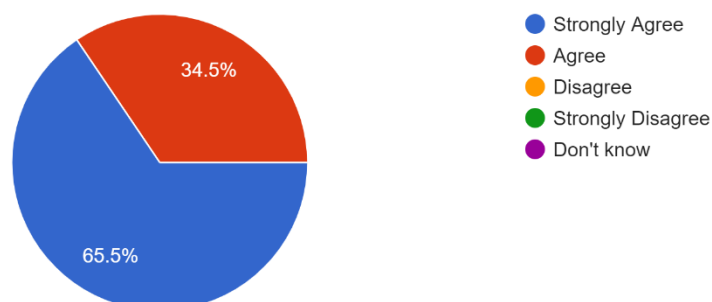

Mrs Blyth is very approachable. Would like more than 10 minutes at parents consultations as I don't feel this is enough. It feels rushed.

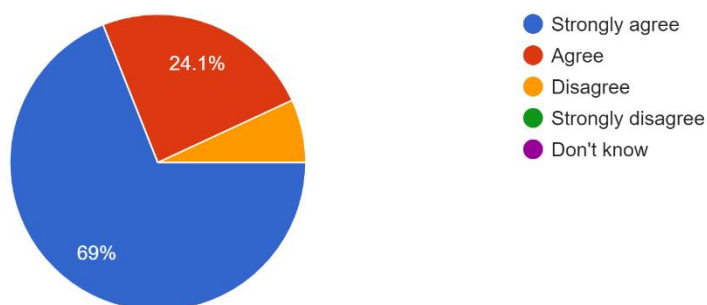
Mrs Blyth is always very responsive and supportive via email.

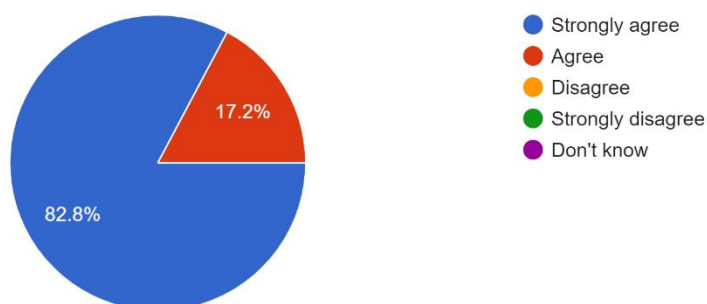
The clubs offered after school are fantastic and provide amazing wrap around support to allow me to work.

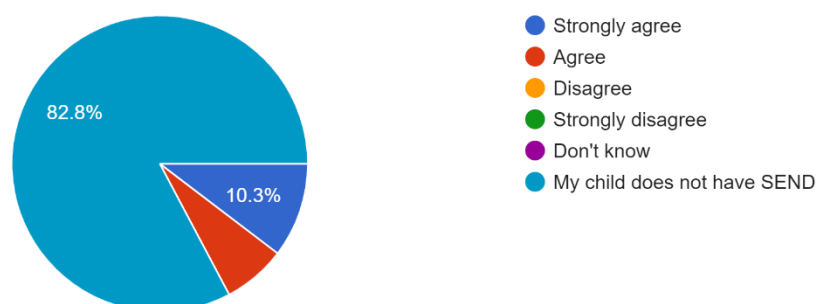

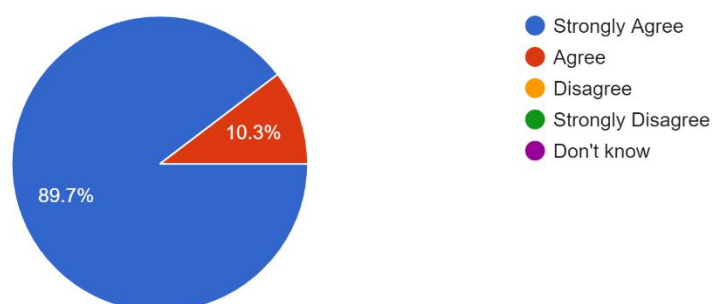
