

Every day the children both tell us of the wonderful things they have done and learnt at school. They wake up in the morning a look forward to school.



Both children feel they can talk to their teachers if anything is worrying them.



She has started putting words together and speaking more clearly (2 yr old)


The teachers all take a lot of care getting to know the children and understanding how they learn and then teach them accordingly. Teachers are attentive and supportive.



Behaviour expectations are high and good behaviour is highly praised


The school supports excellent behaviour and provides support if there are any issues.

We had an immediate response to concerns about bullying. This was dealt with well with the children concerned as well as with us as parents.




No issues at all this year. However, last year I raised one small friendship issue that was resolved immediately.


There are regular parent consultations as well as reports. Even more information would be welcome although time pressures are understood




My child enjoys both of these provisions. The afterschool care has just recently been introduced but is a real hit with my child and other children. We are so fortunate to have these fantastic provisions.




