



Humshaugh Cof E (Aided) First School Sport Premium Proposed Spend Plan 2025-2026

In 2025-2026 the school will receive £16,360. The funding will be used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop children's learning and experience of PE across the whole school. Mr Hulbert is our PE Lead on a part-time basis. He teaches PE to Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 every Monday and in addition leads the extracurricular Sports club after school on a Monday. Mr Hulbert has created an action plan and is enthusiastically developing a variety of ideas to raise the profile of PE including sports leaders, intra school competitions and inter school competitions. We will continue to encourage children to lead healthy and active lifestyles through our teaching and learning and organised events such as Skipping, Dance Marathons, Hoopstarz and wide range of free After School Clubs which include Multi-Skills, Dance, Football and Zumba.

We will actively encourage our children to take part in competitive sport. Having already seen the impact of funding from previous years we hope for this year's funding to continue to have a lasting impact on provision of PE and sport within our school. Areas to address in PE this year are to audit equipment and purchase a range of new items, focus on Lower Key Stage 2 swimming attainment, focus on CPD and progression in PE with our PE Lead and to focus on participation and enjoyment of sport, following the government plan for children to have at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day.
