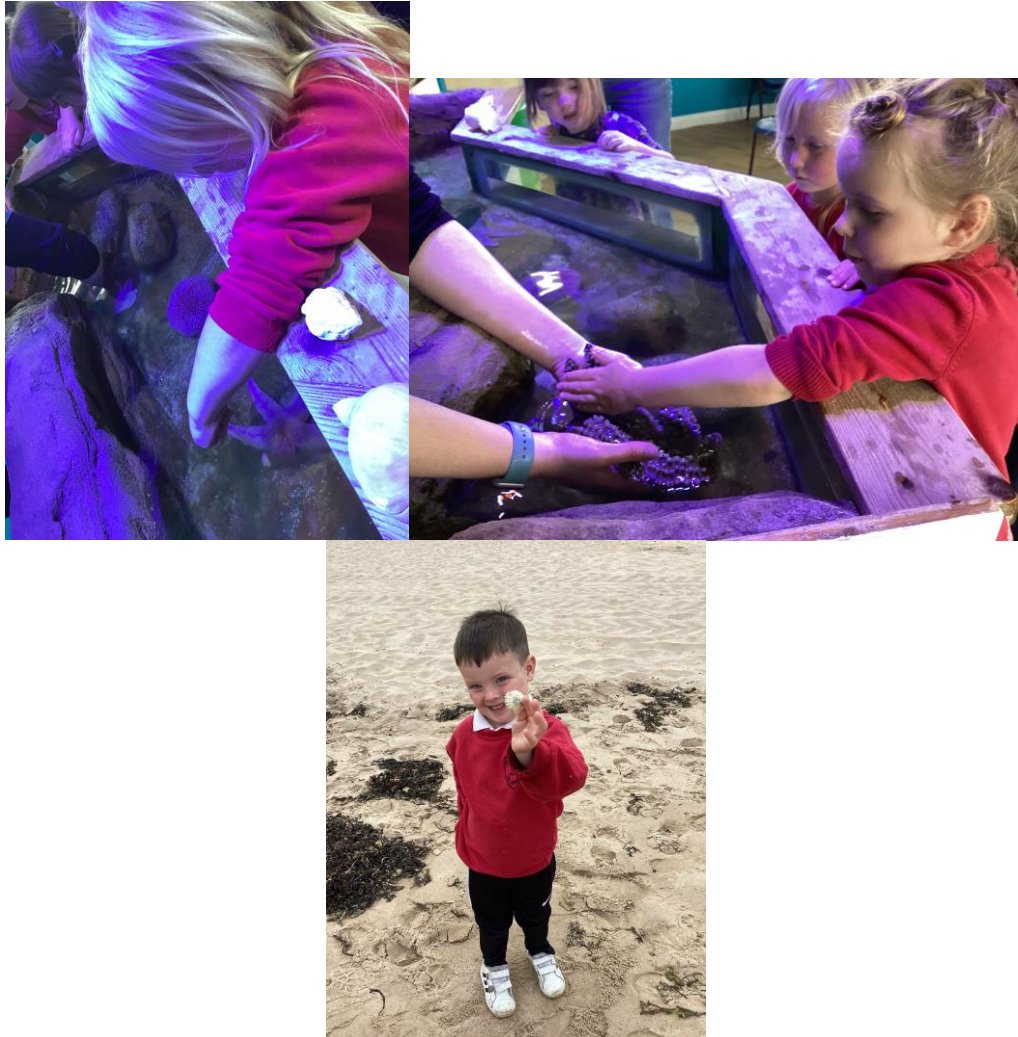
Y4 LEAVER SERVICE
